## Fish & Game New Zealand Fishing Licences

- You must have a licence to fish for trout, salmon and other freshwater sports fish in New Zealand. A Fish and Game license covers all areas of New Zealand except the Taupo fishery area.
- The Fish and Game freshwater fishing season is from 1 October to 30 September.
- A non-resident is a person who is neither a New Zealand citizen (has New Zealand citizenship) nor a permanent resident (holder of a resident visa) as defined in section 4 of the Immigration Act 2009.
- A licence permits you to fish according to the current regulations for each Fish and Game region. The regional regulations define where, when and how you can fish specific waters. They also specify the number of fish you can take each day and may specify the size of fish
- A Fish and Game ranger is likely to ask to see your licence and the fish you have caught. Always comply with the regulations otherwise you can be subject to court prosecution.
